

Beacon Hill FC 2012 Online Registrations

Hello,

Firstly, I would like to take this chance to welcome you to the 2012 football season.

I would also like to let you know that we are changing our registration process for the 2012 season. In the past you would have received a registration form in the mail just before registration. These forms will no longer be issued, and instead all registrations will be completed via an online system known as "MyFootballClub" (www.myfootballclub.com.au).

MyFootballClub is a national online registration system that is used amongst all States and Associations in grassroots football in Australia. The use of this system follows a directive from both Football Federation Australia and Football NSW, and has many benefits to both players and clubs.

The system allows players to register, enter their details, upload a photo and pay individually online. It is now open for 2012 registrations.

Attached you will see a Step by Step guide on how to complete a registration online. The system is ideally suited to single registrations. Other variations can be handled, eg. family discount, dual-mixed-plus-girls registrations, and youth club levy waiver. Detailed guidelines are included in the Notes section of the attachment, however if you want to dive right in, go to www.myfootballclub.com.au, click on Register Now, Register, Player Registration, and either Find your FFA number (need only your name and date-of-birth) or create a new one if you've never been a player.

The club will still be holding registration information days at Beacon Hill Primary School in Tristram Ave on Sat.28.Jan and Sat.4.Feb between 10am and 3pm. You will be able to make registration enquiries, pay cash, collect socks, deliver proof-of-age documentation and purchase gear on the above dates. If you are a returning player who pays online and you have no further questions, you don't need to attend, though you are always welcome to do so.

Information about Grading Days will be posted on the club website - www.beaconhillfc.com in the Diary Dates section.

Please ensure that you have followed the steps in the BHFC Player Registration PDF document and have completed a self registration **before** attending a registration day. As part of the online registration process, you will have an invoice emailed to you. Please print this out and bring to the registration day as proof of registration.
